Take Home & Talk Sheet

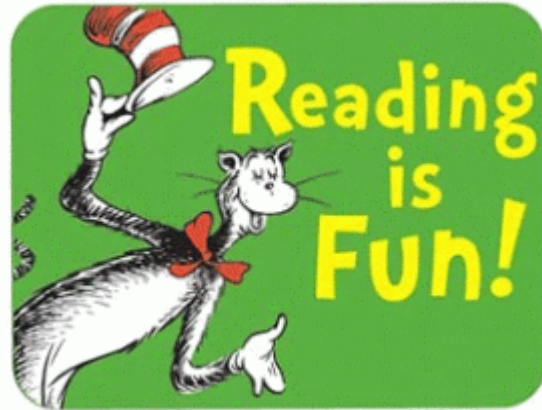
Maths

This week in Maths we have been continuing to count accurately and recognise/write numbers to 5, 10, then 20 and beyond and have introduced counting two sets of objects and adding them together.



Literacy

This week in Literacy we have read a book with every child. Please help them to read it to you at home. A parent signature and/or comment is needed in the planner before we change the book. Thank you.



Phonics

This week in Phonics we have been learning the letter sounds r, h, u, and b. Please can you ask your child to practise forming the letters correctly using the sayings and recognise the letters without the pictures for clues.

Stay and Play

This will now take place on Tuesday 12th December from 8.40 am - 10 am, to coincide with the flu jabs in school. This is an opportunity to stay and play with your child in the setting.

What to focus on when listening to your child read...

Lilac books - Encourage your child to talk about the features of a book e.g. title, author etc. Can your child predict what they think the story will be about? Ask your child to tell a story using full sentences about what is happening in the illustrations. Also ask questions about the, setting, characters and characters feelings.

Pink 1 books - As above and also encourage your child to use their pointy finger when reading, recognise and say the initial sounds of words and use picture clues to help them read unfamiliar words e.g. bear.

Pink 2 books - As above and also encourage your child to recognise the high frequency words and tricky words without sounding them out e.g. go, the, etc, also to segment and blend the CVC words and then re-read the sentence after sounding out.
