PRACTICAL ROAD SAFETY PEDESTRIAN TRAINING FOR YEAR 3

Your child will be taking part in a scheme which introduces them to practical road crossing skills, this involves two training sessions at the roadside.

Dates for roadside training are; 2/05/17 & 9/05/17
(Please make sure your child has suitable footwear and outdoor clothing.)

- The following skills will be taught;
- Choosing safer places to cross.
 - Crossing safely between parked cars.
 - Crossing safely at junctions.

Your child will receive the leaflet ‘Surviving on Jungle Street’ when the training starts. This provides you with more detailed information on these skills.

The training will be delivered by Bradford Council’s Road Safety Team on local roads near the school. Children will be trained in small groups and will be wearing high visibility tops.

It is extremely important that all children take part in this training as it prepares them for future safety on the road. We strongly recommend that they are supervised by an adult whenever crossing the road.
