| Additional playground equipment for break times and lunchtimes. | £1,090 | This equipment was purchased to provide children with a range of activities to play with at playtimes, encouraging team work, and engagement in physical activity. | Children are more active at playtimes and engaged in physical activities, e.g. skipping, ball games. |
| Provided training for dinner supervisors. | £600 | To enable dinner supervisors to introduce playground games and activities at lunchtime. | Dinner times are structured with more opportunities for children to participate in healthy exercise and games. |
| Employing specialist Physical Education teachers and qualified coaches to work alongside teachers in lessons. | £9,680 (Not funded by Sports Grant) | To increase teachers' subject knowledge and confidence in delivering high quality PE lessons. | Teachers are able to plan effective and high quality PE lessons. |
| Qualified coaches employed to deliver football training to all classes at lunchtimes. | £3,840 | To provide children with the opportunity to develop football skills and to take part in inter-house competitions. | Children's skill in football is developing and participation is high. |
| Cricket coaching provided to Year 2 and Year 3 for 8 weeks. | £500 | Provide children with specialist coaching in cricket and prepare them to take part in a local cricket tournament. | Children took part in a competitive tournament and skills and engagement in cricket have been enhanced. |
| After-school sports club run by Fisical Sports. | Not funded by Sports Grant | A large number of children signed up for extra sports coaching. | Pupil engagement and enjoyment enhanced as well as physical activity. |
| Qualified coaches employed to host and organise a local inter-school football competition. | Not funded by Sports Grant | Provide children with the opportunity to participate in a competitive football tournament. | Children took part in a competitive tournament and skills and engagement in football have been enhanced. |
