Dear Parents and Carers

Since the start of the Autumn Term in September 2017, the governors, staff and pupils have been working very hard and with great commitment to address the areas for improvement, set out in the School's Ofsted Inspection Report of July 2017.

On the 18th January, 2018 Wycliffe was visited again by HMI K. Godfrey [Ofsted]. HMI Godfrey carried out a one day inspection, with a specific focus on the leadership of safeguarding and pupils' behavior. She acknowledged many improvements, made by the school in these areas since September and her feedback has helped to shape our next steps and enable further progress.

The report is in the form of a letter.

There will be a further visit from Ofsted towards the end of this school year/at the start of the next school year when the school's progress in addressing all of the areas for improvement, set out in the 2017 report, will be evaluated.
