

English

In English this half term we will be looking at traditional tales and fairy stories, leading up to writing our own at the end of term.

Reading is still very important. Please hear your child read at least three times a week and ask questions to ensure understanding of the text and story.

Don't forget to sign your child's diary so they can change their book.

It is the children's responsibility to change their reading book and they are invited to do this every morning.

Daily phonics work will continue to take place in small groups across KS1 five times a week. This half term the children will all take part in the phonics screening; this will be 1:1 with a familiar adult, reading a range of alien and real words. Maths

In maths we will be covering:

- Learning how to recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- Learning how to recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- Deepening understanding of doubling, multiplication as 'x lots of x' and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Continuing to practise key maths facts- number bonds, counting and addition/subtraction.
