

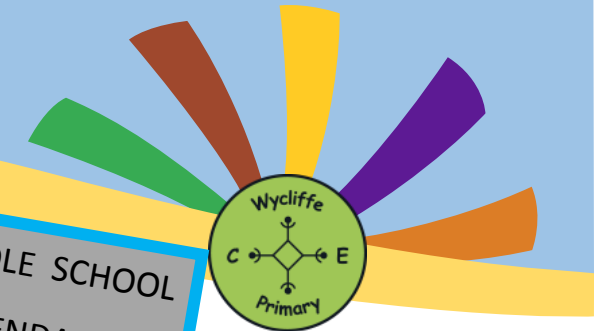

We have recently seen a dip on our attendance figures. Can we remind all parents and carers that our policy (on our website) will be adhered to in relation to requests for term-time holidays. The only authorised absences will be in *exceptional* circumstances at the Headteacher's discretion. **Five days or more unauthorised absence within a 6 week time-frame will see parents liable for a penalty notice.** Although we try to be sympathetic to individual cases, we hope you understand that our attendance team are bound to DfE regulations which came into force in September 2013. As far as illnesses are concerned, any child who is not accounted for by a phone call or message on each day of absence, will be a welfare concern and we shall instruct an immediate home visit as part of our safeguarding duties.

A message from our neighbouring Head Teacher, Trevor Loft, from the Central PRU:

"The school are aware of a few unsettling incidents in recent weeks. Please be assured are working with the police and the local community to resolve the anti-social behaviour being displayed by a minority of our young people.
