**Reading:** Finish listening to the story 'Who Let The Gods Out' at your leisure. Think about the comprehension Qs from last week.


**Growth Mindset:** If possible, listen to 'After the Fall' by Dan Santat.


### MUSIC

There are more problems on the attached pdf. You don't need to print the pages, but you might need to do some working out in your jotter.




What fraction of the bees are coloured in?
