A message from Mrs Sawyer

WELL-BEING

Our children's wellbeing has always been our main focus at Wycliffe. However, at this complicated and difficult time, we have put further measures in place to ensure that the school is a safe haven in which our pupils can be open about their feelings. PSHE is now at the heart of our curriculum. When the children first began in September, we began by talking about our current context and gathering information about our children's recent experiences. All teachers then tailored their PSHE to the needs of the children in their bubbles. Our PSHE long term plan has also been edited to ensure that all classes are being taught 'Health and Wellbeing' topics as a priority this half term. Mindfulness activities linked to breathing, imagination, music and nature are now being practised more regularly across school. All classes now have an accessible space in which the children can communicate their emotions without having to state this verbally. This facilitates further opportunities for staff to monitor, discuss and act to ensure a nurturing environment. Classroom doors were also decorated with the pupils to ensure that the start to the day, literally as the pupils walk through the door, is a happy and welcoming one. We are here to support all of our lovely Wycliffe families at this very unusual time and always.
