Re: School meal price increase.

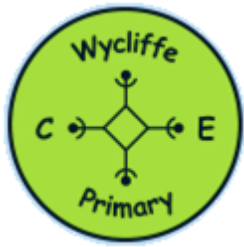
We have been informed by Bradford Council's catering services that the price of school dinner for primary school children as of 1st January 2021 will remain the same at £1.90 per day. Dinner money for one week will be £9.50. You can pay weekly, monthly or termly.

We only accept payment via ParentPay, as we no longer have the facility to accept cash for dinners. If you need the login details for your child(ren) please contact the school office team.

Don't forget to apply for free school meals as your child may be eligible. If your claim is successful, this will help your child and the school hugely with funding towards resources. Please see attached flyer for more information.

Can I apply for free school meals?

You can apply for school meals if you receive:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving Working Tax Credit
- the 'Guaranteed' element of the State Pension Credit
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (you will need to apply directly to the school or call the Education Service on 01274 439393)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income threshold of less than £7,400

School meals are free for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 - why do I still need to apply?

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 get free school meals, but if you receive one of the benefits from the list above you may also get help with:

- school uniform costs

For each child registered for free school meals, schools receive a pupil premium of £1,300 (Primary schools) or £935 (Secondary schools) per year. This money is to help your child achieve their best at school.
