Red Light, Green Light

Another classic childhood game. Here are some tips for using this game to work on your child's listening skills:

- Once your child gets the hang of the concepts of green-means-go and red-means-stop, add in another colour "light" to the mix! Try purple light means hop like a bunny or yellow light for crawling, orange light for turning around, blue light for clapping etc.
- A tip to help your child understand the directions at first: Make signs
 with the colours you will use in the game with pictures of the motor
 movements on them. So if you did purple-is-hop-like-a-bunny you can
 make a round purple "light" and put a picture of a bunny on it as a
 visual reminder. Then slowly take the signs away and have your child
 play JUST by listening.
