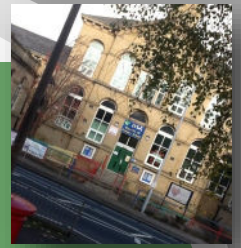

A reminder to not send your child to schools with toys/balls/games etc brought in from home. It leads to upset, fall outs and on occasion items going missing or getting broken.

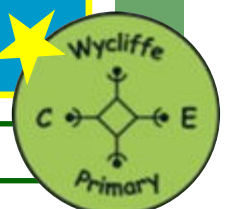
