

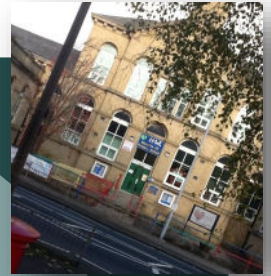

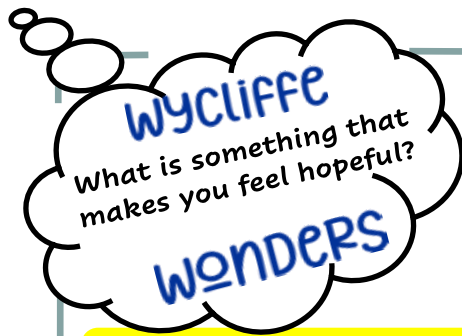
Number Day

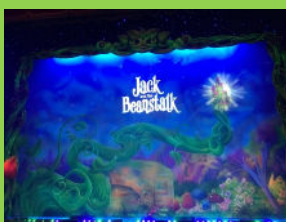
