- I wish there was more government support for children in year 5, but I think the school do the best they can with the behaviour issues.
- Year 5... behaviour... continues to be an issue across the year – which does concern us.
- Playground issues between the students must be monitored better and information should be passed on to class teachers as a lot of the time this gets forgotten
- Be lovely to have some more music provision
- Child would like to spend more time in garden and learning outside
- It would be great if the trim trail and garden were open for playtimes. It is a lovely space that seems wasted at the moment
- We like the homework hexagons, but feel it would also be useful to have homework sheets to complete, especially to help us practice some maths
- The summer fair was wonderful... more similar events would be lovely
- More social events in class and school

- Parking is becoming a big issue. Tolerance from parents on foot and the neighbourhood would be appreciated
- Improve dinner menu
- Would be good if I could get more detailed information about Z's achievements and adjustment at school
