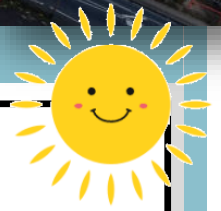
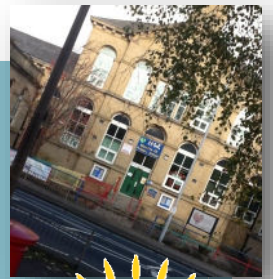

We are having a huge push on behaving in the 'Wycliffe Way' this term – your children are embracing this and we have had a very happy start to the year!

Staying Safe: The health and safety of the children of Wycliffe is of the highest importance and therefore I ask parents not to enter the school building unless it is to visit the school office. If you need to speak to your child's teacher a member of the office staff will see if they are available, if not, a message will be passed on or an appointment made for a later date. Please use the main entrance for this purpose. I would like to remind you that you are not allowed to smoke or vape in or on the school premises, which includes the school's playground. Please remember to inform school if you have changed your address and/or phone number (including mobiles) - it is crucial that we can contact you in an emergency. **Parking causes us many concerns—please remain a considerate driver.**

Timings: A reminder that school gates open at 8.35am, and ensure that your child is on time. Arrival after 8.45 means an office entry and please note that a pupil arriving after 8.55am will be marked as 'Late'. A pupil arriving after 9.10am will be marked as 'Absent'.
