
Our topic this half term is:

OUR AMAZING PLANET WOULD YOU LIVE IN A PLACE LIKE THIS?



English

Our class text is Dear Earth. Using this text, we will retell the story from a different point of view. We will also be writing our own debates about renewable energy to our local council.



Maths

This half term, we are continuing to focus on fractions, decimals and percentages. We will learn to find a fraction of an amount, find equivalnet fractions, decimals and percentages and compare and order decimals. We will also learn how to round decimals to the nearest whole and to 1 decimal place



GEOGRAPHY / HISTORY

Our learning in Geography will see us continuing our travels around the world. On our travels, we will be visiting Australia, Asia and Europe, learning



about the human effects on the Great Barrier Reef, understanding the causes and effects of earthquakes, tsunamis and floods and the effect of volcanoes on settlements. To conclude, we will be deciding where we would most like to live in the world and why.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about plants. Our learning will include identifying what makes up a plant, what they need to grow and how water is transported within plants. We will also learn about the importance of flowers in the life cycle of flowering plants.



On a Tuesday we will be going swimming. Please ensure you bring your swimming kit to school every Tuesday. Our other PE lesson (for both classes) will be on a Thursday. This half term we will be developing our skills in Tennis. Please remember to come in your full kit, with long hair already tied back. Earrings will need to be removed or please provide tape to cover them.

This half term we will be using recycled materials to make a quilt suitable for a small animal. We will design, make and evaluate our product. If you have any spare, unwanted fabric, please send this to school as soon



as possible for us to use to make our quilts.

RE

This half term our big question is: How can following God bring freedom and justice? In this topic we will be learning about the Old Testament, the story of Moses and how Christians try to bring freedom to others.



PSHE

Our big question is 'How will we grow and change?'. In this unit, we will be



learning about puberty and the changes that happen as we grow. (Additional communication has been sent out about this)

In Muric, we will be learning our topic ong 'It', the Dolphin Symphony'. which will be played on the glockenspiels.

In Computing, we will be learning about Flat file databases.
