Areas for development

- There is a tendency to use well-behaved children to help look after / chaperone those who are not so. I don't believe this is ultimately fair. Ultimately more TAs are needed, **but I realise there will not be the budget for this.**
- SEN needs more work for all SEN kids to feel.
- It has become apparent that there is a bullying issue with older children. There also seems to be too much focus on the SEND kids.
- Sometimes picked on but not dealt with.
- With Year 2 SATS I think children should have been taught some aspects earlier.
- Would love to see more music offer from school in class as well as after school + more time in the green area.
- Food on open mornings.
- I would like to see some big plants and vines in front of school to block pollution.

- On the days when it is fancy dress world Booked Day / another themed day, please send the text the week before, not the morning of. **Such events are in all newsletter weeks in advance.**
- Need to support children who struggle with confidence. Need more opportunity to interact with teachers.
- Think my child could be pushed more / challenged more. Not enough focus on more academically able children.
- Please can we stop puddings at school and stop sweets being brought in to share with kids.
- I feel my child has been held back and not challenged / stretched enough.
- Slow support for additional needs. Has to be driven by parents.
- Would it be possible to run art workshops?
- If there is any activities to consider parents who work during the morning had to take time of sometime and try to do them in the afternoon.
- He wishes he could play football in school and have bigger food portions.
- Would like a wider range of after school clubs / activities (not sports focused).
- More focus on mental wellbeing – behaviour system creates too much pressure and external behaviour is more valued than internal feelings – wish it was more holistic.
