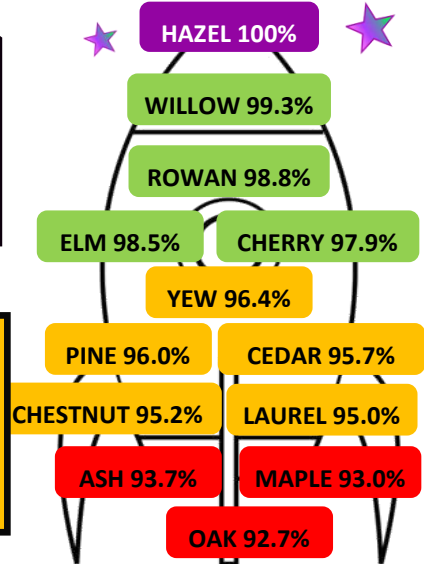

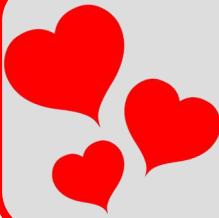

Is Fortnite appropriate for your child? What age should children be allowed to play Fortnite?

For some parents, the cartoonish, bloodless style of the action in Fortnite makes the violence less problematic than the aggression in other popular shooter games. But the game's online chat feature—especially in Battle Royale mode—could expose younger players to offensive language or mature content from random strangers. **Most UK research recommends Fortnite for teens 13 and up, primarily because of the action violence.**
