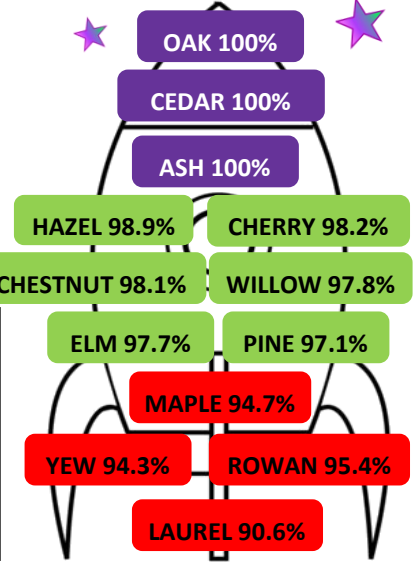

This week, Year 6 enjoyed their Food Technology Day making Empanadas.

This is what they got up to (written by Year 6 pupils Finlay & Joey)

We started by listening to the safety talk about using knives and the hot oven. Then, we chopped peppers and peeled and diced onions. We peeled and grated the carrots and chopped potatoes then tipped them in a roasting tray to cook them.

We made the dough by mixing the flour and salt. Then we poured 7 tablespoons of olive oil into the mixture. We rubbed together the flour to get rid of any lumps, added water, and kneaded the dough. After we rolled the dough and cut it into circles, we added the filling that was cooked and cooled down.

Whilst the empanadas were cooking we figured out the cost of the ingredients and estimated the amount it cost to make them. This helped us decide how much we could sell them to make a profit!

It was a really fun day!
