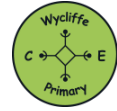

Our topic this half term is **Go Wild!**

English

We will begin our final term in Year 1 by looking at tales from different cultures, with our main texts being 'We all went on safari'. Using this core texts, we will be writing our very own fact files on wild animals to create an encyclopedia and a setting description.



Maths

This half term, we will start by looking at measurement focusing on weight and volume, using lots of practical resources to help us. We will then move onto place value within 100 alongside counting in our 2s, 5s and 10s.



History/Geography

In Geography, we will become explorers and look at the different continents and oceans as well as focusing on the UK. We will then look at hot and cold places in relation to the equator and link this to our science topic about animals.



Science

Our big question is 'Can you keep a monkey as a pet in Shipley?' Our focus will be finding out all about different animals, identifying and grouping them. Our findings will help us to answer our big question.

In PE, we will be focusing on developing our athletic skills ready to participate in the school sports day. We will also be working on our skills of hitting, catching and running.

RE - Our big question this half term is 'Who do Christians say made the world?'. We will be exploring the Creation Story in detail and learning to retell this.

In PSHE, our topic is 'Who keeps us safe?' We will be learning about who is in our community. That can help us and also what to do if we need help and don't feel safe.

Music

Our focus within Music will be to look at a variety of instruments and have a go at playing some of them. We will also be learning a new class song all about the continents.



Computing – Creating media is our focus for learning in Computing. Using different tools to create digital writing, we will make front covers for our stories.

French

In French, we will be learning to say the names of animals.



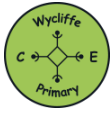
Homework

Reading

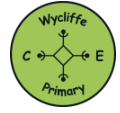
