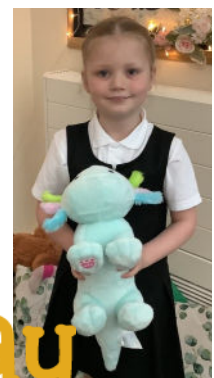
PLEASE DRIVE SAFE


