


Year 1 Newsletter

Our topic this half term is Go Wild!

English

We will be finishing our year by writing some animal inspired poetry. In preparation for this, we will be looking at a variety of poems and focusing on writing shape poems using the text "Zeraffa Giraffa". We will then move on to writing some postcards to characters in our class story 'There is a tiger in the garden'.





Maths

This half term, we will finish our unit of place value within 100. We will then move on to shpaes. The last topic of the term will be time. We will be focusing on o'clock and half past the hour. It would be greatly beneficial if you could encourage your child to tell the time when at home.

History/Geography

Within History and Geography, we will be exploring Shipley and studying maps and aerial photographs to pick out the human and physical features. We will then be comparing Shipley to Tanzania to decide where would be the best place for a monkey to live.

Science

For our final topic, we are looking at a variety of plants and trees. We will be making use of our edible garden and

even creating our own mini herb garden.
