

## Year 1 and Year 2

We are trying something different this year in Y1. This coincides with the need to introduce a Y1/2 mixed class alongside both a Y1 only and a Y2 only class.

Both the Y1 class and the mixed Y1/2 class will effectively be treated as one big class, led by both Mrs Sawyer and Miss Ramsey. We are introducing a level of explorative and child led provision into Y1, in order to ease the transition from Early Years.

We have thought carefully about the children that are part of the Y1/2 mixed class. We have considered a range of factors when deciding who is in this class and who is in the Y2 only class. We believe that those Y2 children who are in the mixed class will be best supported by the flexibility built into the new Y1 and Y1/2 space.

All children, whether in the Y1, Y1/2 mixed and Y2 class, will receive the learning required for that curriculum year group, adapted to their specific needs.

## **Nurture provision**

Working in our Nurture SEND provision is Mr Hussain, Mrs Breen and Mrs Dar. We are planning to increase the size of this provision over the Summer and into the Autumn in order to better provide for those children that utilise this provision in school.

- Mrs Donnelly, Mrs Docherty, Miss Roche and Miss Thompson are all moving on to other schools.


