Dear parents/carers,

With only a few days left until the end of the school year, I wanted to write to you all with a few notices ahead of the return in September.

Supervision

Please can we ask that children are closely supervised before school begins. We have had a number of reports of children climbing gates, fences and disturbing flower beds etc. Also, for a calm and safe handover to take place in the morning, it is important that parents accompany children into the school grounds and ensure they meet the staff member waiting for them.

Uniform

Over the summer, you may be planning to renew your child's uniform. Full details on our expectations are available on the school website: [School Uniform – Wycliffe CE Primary School](#). As the year draws to a close, we are noticing that uniform is becoming a little inconsistent. I know, with the holiday approaching, many families are waiting before buying new pieces. I would ask that uniform is checked carefully over the summer and that all children have full uniform and correct footwear from the first day back in school.

House points

With the successful introduction of Class Dojo throughout school and the children earning Dojo Points and rewards, we have decided to retire the school Houses. The children will still earn points and receive rewards for these points, but these will be Dojo points. As such, moving forward, your child will only need a white t-shirt for PE. Your child can continue to wear their current house colour PE t-shirt until they outgrow it and a new one is required.

Newsletters

Again, as we continue to add to our communications on Dojo, we have decided to reduce the number of school newsletters. These will now be provided once every half term, summarising some of the news from Class Dojo and elsewhere.

Scooters

We very much encourage children actively travelling to and from school every day. As well as walking to school, some children like to use a bike or scooter. These can then be stored in school or taken back home again by parents.

However, from September, the children will no longer be using the scooters during the school day. As not every child has access to a scooter, this can cause some upset. We will be developing ways for more equal outdoor learning and activity. Bikes should be secured with a lock in the bike storage area outside school on Back Baker Street and scooters should be brought into the



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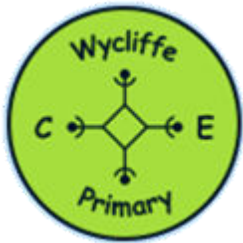
