TRUE OR IS IT JUST A STORY?




English

Our class text will be War Horse. We will be using this to help us write about animals going to war, along with a discussion text about War Horse. We will be focusing on our spelling and handwriting along the way in order to produce some wonderful pieces of writing.



Maths

This half term, we are focusing on place value. We will learn how to read Roman Numerals and read, write, compare and order numbers to at least one million!

HISTORY/GEOGRAPHY

Our learning in History will be all about World War One which will be introduced on our Wow Day. We will be learning about what led to the start of WW1 and understand what life was like

between 1914 and 1918, including the involvement of animals. We will link this with geography to understand the countries involved and where the war took place.

<u>Science</u>

Our first unit will be scientific enquiry based on the properties of materials. We will be working as scientists to predict, observe and test out our hypothesis. We will explore the properties of solids, liquids and gases and learn how to carry out a fair test.

PE

PE will be taught on **Wednesdays** and **Fridays**. This half term, we will be developing our skills in hockey and outdoor adventurous activities.

Art

This half term, we will be creating a piece of artwork on silhouette soldiers. We shall focus on drawing the effect of light on people and objects from

different directions and develop the concept of perspective.

RE

This half term our big question is: What does it mean if God is holy and loving? In this topic, we shall explore who God is, understand the importance of proverbs and learn about different ideas of God.

2SHE

Our big question will be 'What makes up our identity' and within this topic we will discuss gender, faith, culture, ethnicity, faith and likes/dislikes. We will learn about what it means to live in a diverse community and understand the importance of respect and acceptance.



Music

In Music, we will be learning how to play the trumpets as well as learn about the song 'Livin on a prayer' by Bon Jovi. We will appraise and compose the song throughout this term.

Computing Mr Stirk wil

Mr Stirk will be focusing on sharing information in computing this half term; such as exploring the world wide web, what we can use it for and how to use it safely.

French

This half term in French we will be learning about animals, including our pets. We will focus on pronunciation and retrieval of key words.
