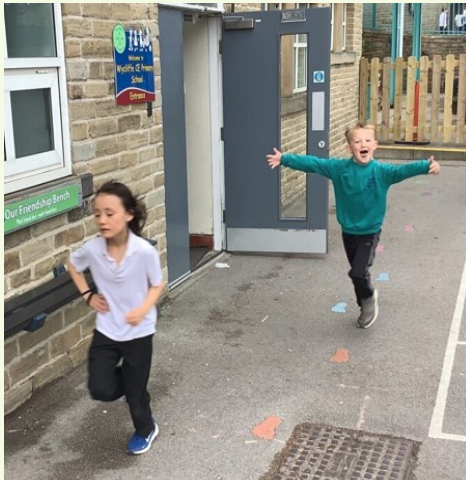

Well done to all the children and staff who completed the Mini London Marathon! We are so proud of their determination, enthusiasm, and fantastic effort.

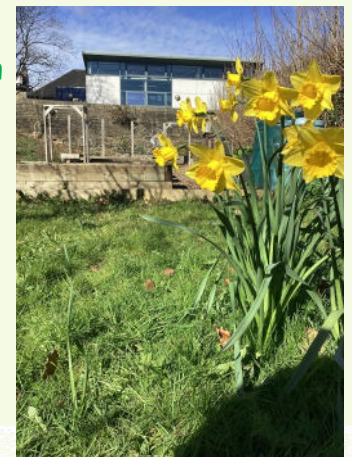


Year 6 @ The Brownlee mini triathlon

Some reminders about club bookings.

- Ensure your child is booked in on ParentPay before the session starts. This is 07:45 for breakfast club and 15:15 for after school club.
- If you no longer require the club booking, you can cancel the sessions on ParentPay before the session starts. This will add a credit to your account.
- Sessions need to be booked and paid for in advance.
- If you are paying by childcare vouchers or tax-free childcare, please send a screenshot of the payment to the office email address and we will add the balance to ParentPay for you.
- Please ensure you sign your child in and out of breakfast club and after school club on the screen in the main entrance.
- If you have booked the short session for after school club and you collect later than 16:45 we will amend the booking to charge for the longer session up to 18:00.
- If your child is at sports club and you are not here to collect at 16:15, your child will be sent to after school club and an additional charge of £5.50 per child will be added to your account.
- If you cannot see a particular session on ParentPay, this means it is fully booked. Please contact the school office to find out if we have and availability. Do not just send your child, as we staff the sessions according to numbers booked.

*School finishes at 15:15, if your child is not collected by 15:30 a late pickup fee will issued.

All additional charges are added at the schools discretion.
